Are Urinary Tract Infections Being Measured Correctly? Maybe Not and \$373 Million in Federal Fines May Be At Stake.

Catheter-associated urinary tract infections (CAUTIs) occur in 290,000 U.S. hospital patients annually, with an estimated cost of \$290 million. Two different measurement systems are being used to track these infections. One has shown a 28.2% decrease, since 2010 and the other has shown a 3% to 6% increase since 2009. A hospital's rate of urinary catheter

infections make up almost a third of CMS's Hospital Acquired Condition penalty, which can penalize a hospital by 1% of its entire annual Medicare payment. It is recommended that the discrepancies in these two methods be reconciled and that a new measurement system be developed which takes into account efforts to decrease catheter utilization.
