

## HW USA Letter to the CDC Supporting Action Regarding the High Incidence of Occult Cancer in Hysterectomy Specimens

"Health Watch USA strongly supports the announcement that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention plans to take action on the pre-operative evaluation of women scheduled for hysterectomy or myomectomy, using the non-oncological techniques such as morcellation. A recent article in the journal Obstetrics and Gynecology (Desai VB, et al, April 13, 2018) found an astonishingly high risk of unsuspected uterine, cervical and ovarian cancers (1.44%, 0.60%, and 0.19%, respectively) in women undergoing uterine operations for presumably benign conditions." #### The Never-Ending Misuse of Antipsychotics In Nursing Homes

HealthAffairs: "In response to a generic question about post-market drug surveillance posed during a February 2007 House Energy and Commerce Committee hearing, Dr. David Graham, then associate director of science and medicine in the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA's) Office of Surveillance and Epidemiology, stated: "I would pay careful attention to antipsychotic medications. ... The problem with these drugs are that we know that they are being used extensively off label in nursing homes to sedate elderly patients with dementia ... . It is known that the drugs don't work in those settings. ... But the fact is, is that it increases mortality perhaps by 100 percent. It doubles mortality. So I did a back-of-the-envelope calculation on this and you probably got 15,000 elderly people in nursing homes dying each year from the off-label use of antipsychotic medications for an indication that FDA knows the drug doesn't work. This problem has been known to FDA for years and years and years."
